





Life expectancy at birth


Life expectancy at age 65



The need for annuities

- CPF members start receiving their monthly payouts from their Retirement Account (RA) from age 65.
 - Expected to last for about 20 years only

CPF LIFE

- Introduced in 2009
- Started out as opt-in scheme
 - open to all citizens and permanent residents age 55 and above.
- Made mandatory in 2013
 - cover automatically extended to all citizens and permanent residents who turned 55 with at least S\$40,000 in their Retirement Account.
- Eligible members choose from 2 plans

Key features of CPF LIFE

Basic & Affordable

- Premiums paid from Retirement Account (RA) and are refundable upon death.
- Steady income for life.

Fair

- Premiums and payouts are actuarially determined and reviewed periodically to reflect actual mortality and investment outcomes.
- Payouts are dependent on what members have saved in their Retirement Account.

Flexible

- Members allowed options to choose plans according to their retirement needs.






^RA : Retirement Account

Risks

Investment risk

CPF monies are backed by special Singapore Government Securities.

Mortality risk

Automatic inclusion to reduce the risk of adverse selection.

Payouts are not guaranteed but reviewed yearly and adjust when necessary to reflect actual experience.


